SVL90-2 TRACK LOADER

Productivity, performance in a compact design

WITH best-in-class bucket breakout force and enhanced lifting capacity backed by a 90hp output (making it around 30% more powerful than a typical competing model in its class), Kubota's SVL90-2 has been built to offer high performance, reliability and comfort in a compact loader.

Among the features helping to boost owner-operator productivity is Kubota's unique vertical lift design, delivering

a reach of just over 1 metre, with an arm tip that is optimally-shaped for a tall hinge pin height of 3.2 metres.

Kubota believes this feature will be particularly useful for applications such as loading dump trucks.

The efficiency, fuel economy and relatively-quiet engine (when compared to competitor products) on the SVL90-2 is a result of Kubota's Common Rail System (CRS) technology, which electronically controls the fuel injection timing and amount in stages, rather than all at once.

The machine also boasts a combination of Kubota's Exhaust Gas Recirculation (EGR) and a Diesel Particulate Filter (DPF) muffler to reduce emissions to well within compliance regulations.

Operators are well looked-after, with a spacious cabin offering a wide entrance, 360° visibility, high-back full suspension seating, arm rests and extra leg room designed to improve safety, enhance comfort, minimise fatigue and maintain productivity. The cab is also pressurised to keep dust and debris out.
